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Our Policy On Slavery and Human Trafficking

We act ethically and with integrity towards our employees and in all our business relationships. In addition, we ensure that we meet applicable legal and ethical standards. Procedures on Slavery and Human Trafficking

As part of our compliance with the policy referred to above, we already take the following steps:

- Assess potential risk areas in our supply chains;
- Monitor potential risk areas in our supply chains on a periodic basis;
- Use bespoke contract terms or our standard terms and conditions of purchase, where possible.

In addition to the steps we currently take and to the policies referred to above, we will enhance our processes and mitigate the risk of slavery and human trafficking occurring in our supply chains by reviewing, where necessary, the controls that our suppliers have in place and carrying out other suitable checks.

Responsibility for ensuring that our procedures are adequate and are adhered to in all areas of our activities rests with the directors of Quick Circuits Ltd.
